


Registered Nurses (RNs)

Student Enrollment

A total of 1,150 open seats were available, 1,122 applicants were qualified to fill a seat; 878 (78%) accepted and enrolled in a program; leaving 272 (24%) seats vacant.

60% were SD residents 78% were 30 years or younger 84% were female

84% were Caucasian 3% were American Indian


Graduates

801 passed the national licensure exam and were licensed
